## QUALITY ASSURANCE PROGRAMME

## The works basically shall address the issues classified as distresses, described below:

- 1. The contractor should maintain the road from Rail siding to CHPP free of dust, mainly due to the spillage that occurs during coal transportation,
- 2. The contractor should maintain the haul road with no ripples or corrugated surface;
- 3. Maintain the road free of pot holes;
- 4. The contractor should maintain the road without gravels, Lose material on the road surface (typically +25 mm), due to poor compaction;
- 5. The contractor should maintain the road surface smooth;
- 6. The works should be also addresses to the Formation of longitudinal depression, as result of consolidation or lateral movement caused by loaded trucks.
- 7. Raveling: Loosing of surface material due to the traffic, when aggregate particles are dislodged or loss/decrease of binding property.
- 8. Spot gravelling: Over areas that became excessively thin or worn through and for filling potholes, erosion channels and corrugations
- 9. The road berms must be well-shaped for water drainage and maintained clean to guarantee
- 10. Reworking and compaction: Works related to breaking down or removal of the existing oversized gravel and blending with fines, adding moisture and compacting;
- 11. Spot gravelling: Over areas that became excessively thin or worn through and for filling potholes, erosion channels and corrugations;
- 12. Contractor will adhere to the HSE policy of ICVL as described in the Contract.
