With reference to the GLOBAL OPEN TENDER NO “MBL/TM/2024-25/01” DATED 15th July 2024 FOR COAL MINING OPERATION SERVICE, MBL had uploaded the latest pit shells, lead and lift data of mines for all prospective bidders on websites for their reference and evaluation before participation into the bid.

In this regard, MBL wants to inform that any party can carry out Lidar survey with the use of drone, at his own expense to evaluate before bidding with the conditions given below:

- 1) The bidder will be responsible for obtaining all necessary statutory clearances for carrying out the drone survey as per Mozambique rules. Further MBL shall grant permission for carrying out the drone survey at Mines site will be given only after satisfying itself that the prospective bidder has the necessary statutory clearances.
- 2) The prospective bidder agrees to the following;
 - a) The drone survey data / survey report shall only be used for the purpose of preparing / submitting the bid.
 - b) Any survey carried out by bidders shall solely be for their own assessment and will not be certified or binding to ICVL.
 - c) The drone survey data / survey report shall not be shared with any other individual/party/organisation for any reason whatsoever.
 - d) A copy of drone survey data in hard/soft copy shall be shared with MBL immediately after conducting survey.
 - e) If the bidder is not awarded the work, the bidder will destroy/delete all copies (hard/soft) of the survey data/report within one month of award of work, an undertaking shall be given by such bidder.
- 3) The prospective Bidder has to sign the Non- Disclosure Agreement with the MBL.
